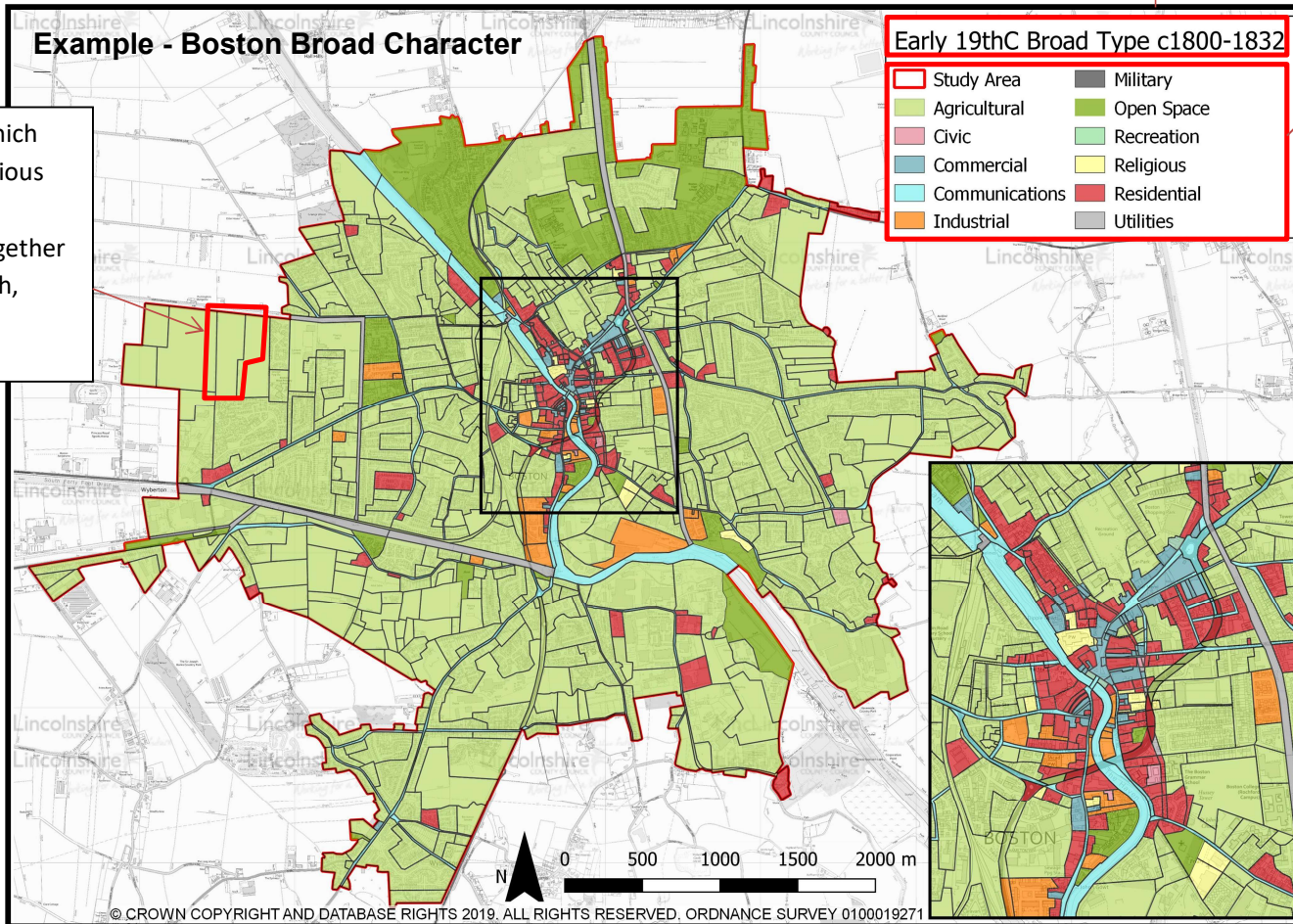


How to use the Historic Urban Character Types Map













The key displays the character of a town at a moment in time; this map shows the character of Boston in the early 19th century.

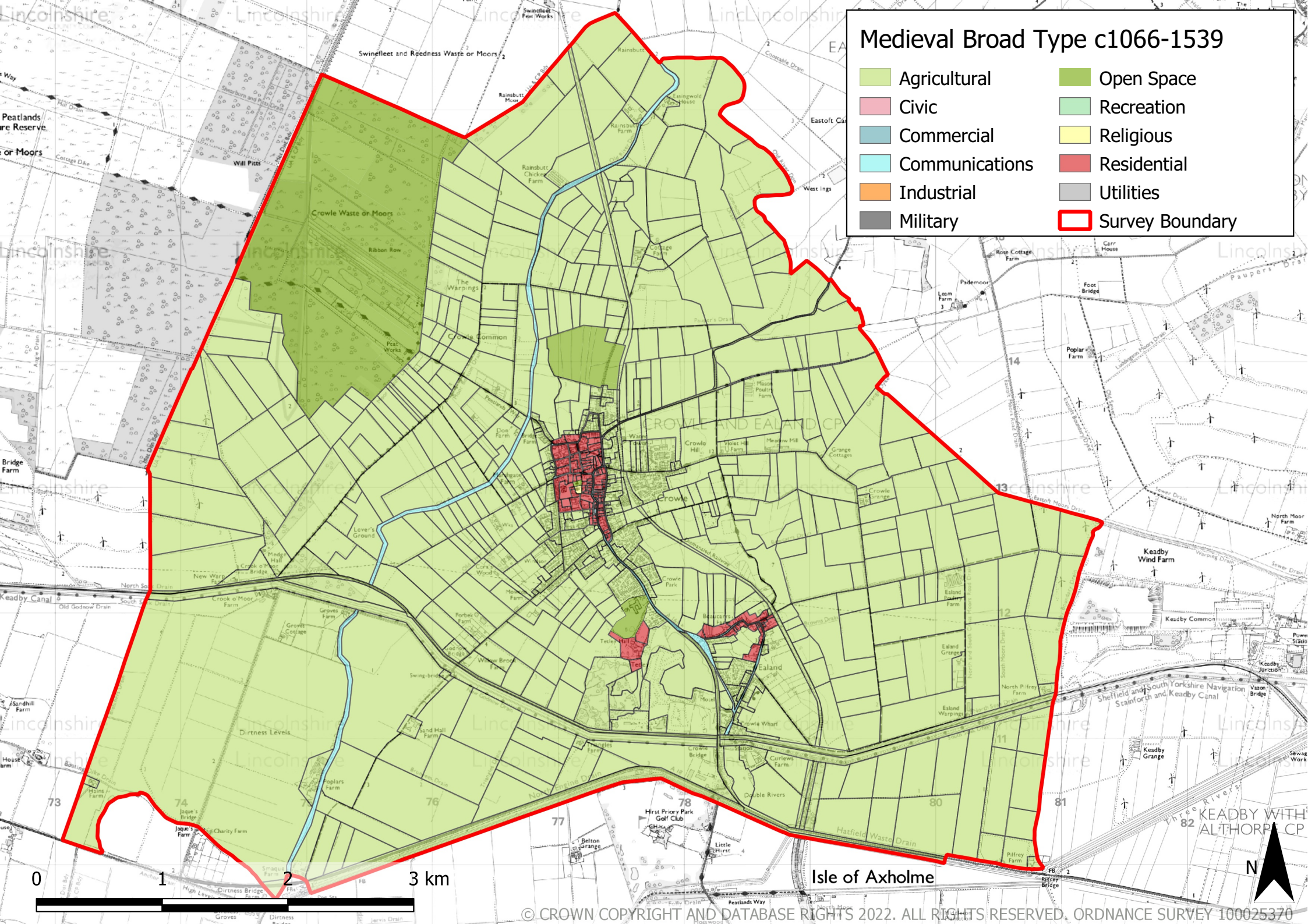
Individual building block; which record the current and previous character and land use of a particular area or space. Together the HUCTs can reveal growth, development patterns and recurrent land use.



The Broad Type shows the general character of a town. You can see here that Boston is built up of almost 1000 character blocks. These demonstrate how a town has morphed and grown over an extended period of time.
